Band Camp Fee: Every band member (color guard, percussion, brass, and woodwind) will be required to pay a band camp fee. This year, the MAJORETTE band camp fee is **\$140.00** then **\$40.00 per additional sibling** in band. This will cover the cost of band camp instructors, music, drill, choreography, a band T-shirt, and other band camp costs.

Uniform Fee: Every majorette member is required to have a uniform. This year, we are taking a unique approach to uniforms. After discussing with a well-renowned fashion designer from New York, we have decided to purchase uniform bases and build from that. The **Uniform Additions and Fitting** fee will cover the cost of those additions to create a unique and durable uniform for our Majorettes.

Boots: Every majorette member must have a pair of white boots. These are the classic, go-go boots that majorette have used for years. You can purchase these shoes at Alabama Music in Florence for about \$60. These boots should last you for the rest of your majorette journey at CHHS. The **Boot Fitting** fee will cover the cost to have the majorette's boot fitted snug to their calf to be more comfortable and reduce the risk injuries during performance.

Tank Tops: During some performances, majorette members will be asked to wear a specific team tank top as their uniform. The two team tank tops will be about \$15 each.

Cover ups: In the stands, on the bus, and other times through the season, majorettes might be asked to wear cover ups to both protect their uniform and for the members to feel more comfortable in public areas. These cover-ups can also be used at cooler games for a light layer to wear over the uniforms.

Winter Gear: When it gets colder in the season, majorettes are the first ones to feel the temperature drop. Having a jacket, pants, and gloves will ensure that the majorettes stay warm enough to be comfortable and perform to the best of their ability.

Head Piece: Our show this year is "The Roarin' 20s". With this theme, majorette members will be wearing a headpiece like those iconic headpieces wore in the 1920s. Each head piece will be about \$25.

Umbrella: One of the most famous songs from the 1920s is "Singin' in the Rain". We will be incorporating this song into the show this year, and the majorettes will be using umbrellas as props.

Stand Towels: These towels are used during football games for majorette members to sit on to prevent any damage to their uniform. If you need/want to order a new towel for this year, it will be about \$15.

Backpack: Majorette members will be carrying many items during games, competitions, and other performances. Team backpacks allow the members to easily distinguish their bags from other groups' and easily carry all personal items throughout events. Members can use backpacks from previous years or order a new one for about \$20.
